## June 2009

*Keene, ON*

\$100,000 saved in commercial fire

**SAVE** Sign shop saved from total loss. FIT prevented the spread of flames, brought down temperature, and made interior attack possible for the fire crew to attack a dangerous chemical fire.

---

## May 2009

*NewCastle, PA*

Family Dog Saved From Fire

**SAVE** Damage contained to living room. The FIT-5 bought time until fire crews arrived on scene and enabled crews to enter the structure and save the homeowner's dog.

---

## April 2009

*Pine Lake, WI*

Wisconsin Trailer Home Saved

**SAVE** FIT knocked the fire down within 15 seconds and significantly reduced water usage to 100 gallons. Had it not been for the FIT-5, the trailer would have been a complete loss.

---

## March 2009

*Rocky Mountain House, AB*

Saves \$100,000 in Property Damages

**SAVE** Fire contained to the basement, leaving the three door garage untouched. Thermal imaging cameras captured a 500°C decrease in temperature 20 seconds after the FIT was deployed.

---

## March 2009

*Demarest, NJ*

Saves Home from Basement Fire

**SAVE** FIT contained fire to the basement, prevented spread of flames, reduced property damage, and saved the structure from total loss.

---

## February 2009

*Wayne, NY*

Fully involved second floor bedroom fire contained.

**SAVE** Fire knocked down containing heat and smoke damage to the second floor. Minimal amount of water used; minimal water damage. Rest of the home remained damage free.

---

## February 2009

*Milan, NY*

Home saved from total loss.

**SAVE** The raging bedroom fire was knocked down and the spread of flames to the rest of the home was prevented. The home that is said to have been a total loss without the FIT-5 can now be restored.

---

## January 2009

*Sechelt, BC*

\$80,000 saved in property damages

**SAVE** The fire department estimates that the \$100,000 structure suffered \$20,000 in damages and would have been a complete loss without the FIT-5. The structure suffered little to no water damage.

---

## December 2008

*Hauppauge, NY*

Boiler room fire knocked down

**SAVE** Finished area of the basement spared from fire damage. Minimal water was used to overhaul the fire. Homeowners were thankful that their possessions were saved and there was no flooding in their home.

---

## November 2008

*Ridge, NY*

FIT-5 saves home from kitchen fire

**SAVE** The FIT-5 stopped the spread of fire into the rest of the living room. Made it possible for crew to safely enter the structure and overhaul the fire. Amount of water used in overhaul was significantly less than what would have been required had the FIT-5 not been deployed.

---

## October 2008

*Pompton Lakes, NJ*

Fully involved second floor fire with thatched roof.

**SAVE** First floor of house spared from fire damage. Roof prevented from collapse. Insurance savings in tens of thousands. Fire fully overhauled in 10 minutes. Could have taken more than hour (and tens of thousands of gallons of water)

**October 2008**

*Jefferson Township, NJ*

Jefferson Township Fire Company #1 knocks down an attic fire in New Jersey home.

**SAVE** The FIT prevented the fire in the attic from spreading to the rest of the home. The homeowner is an 81 year-old man, who required support from the local Red Cross. He will be able to return to his home as a result of the FIT being deployed. 50 gallons of water used. Estimated without FIT – many thousands

---

**September 2008**

*High River, AB*

High River Volunteer FD contained damage to single unit

**SAVE** Damage contained to a single unit in four family dwelling. Families from the other three units were able to return to their homes within hours of the fire. The entire building may have been lost without the FIT.

Arson investigators were able to make arrests the same day, due to the quality of evidence preserved.

---

**August 2008**

*Neshannock, PA*

NewCastle PA Basement Fire Stopped in Tracks

**SAVE** FIT halted an incipient basement fire in its tracks, short of entertainment area. ½ gallon of water used to extinguish smoldering magazines.

---

**September 2008**

*Naramata, BC*

Naramata, BC home saved from fully involved kitchen fire.

**SAVE** Trucks did not arrive for nearly ten minutes. Fire may have consumed entire home. The insurance adjuster estimated the FIT saved the underwriter at least \$100,000.

---

**September 2008**

*Neshannock, PA*

FIT-5 Knocks Down 40-Foot Flames in Pennsylvania

**SAVE** Fully involved single family dwelling. Flame had spread beyond room of origin. Damage contained to primary burn area, removed fire extension from neighboring rooms. Possible entire structure could have gone up without FIT.

---

**June 2008**

*Shelter Island New York*

Shelter Island Home Saved, Very Little Water Used

**SAVE** Contained damage to basement. Did not have ready access to adequate water to fight blaze. 250 gallons. Likely would have used well over 1,000.

---

**May 2008**

*2 Mile BC*

FIT-5 Knocks Down Trailer Fire

**SAVE** Fire spread from bbq outside building to inside the kitchen. Trailer would have been a complete loss without FIT. Fewer than 300 gallons of water to fully extinguish.

---

**April 2008**

*West Milford, NJ*

FIT-5 Knocks Down Basement Fire and Saves House

**SAVE** Damage contained to basement. Important family documents, including savings bonds that were kept in the basement were spared from damage. Approximately 100 gallons used to fully extinguish.

---

**January 2008**

*Leduc Alberta*

Neighboring Property Saved From Flame Spread When Hydrants Failed

**SAVE** The fire was pulled back into the house for almost fifteen minutes, enough time for the relay truck to arrive and overhaul the fire. The neighboring house and an RV would have become involved and seriously damaged without FIT.

---

**December 2007**

*Port Jervis, NY*

Lives and Property Saved

**SAVE** The FIT-5 greatly reduced the risk to these firefighters, and minimized damage in what was developing into a very serious fire. Had the propane canister in the closet exploded, it would have seriously injured or killed all firefighters on scene, and would have caused major damage to neighboring buildings.
